



**Policy:** [Home Study Students – Code C6](#)

**Procedural Requirements:**

The Superintendent will develop administrative procedures that comply with rules promulgated by the Vermont State Board of Education as is necessary to implement this policy.

**Procedure:**

Upon receipt from the VT AOE, the Superintendent or designee will disseminate the list of students to MVSD schools for tracking and truancy purposes.

Families receive a “complete” letter from the VT AOE when they have submitted the required documentation. Schools can request that families provide a copy of their “complete” letter as proof that their children are enrolled in a Home Study Program.

School principals, registrars, and guidance staff may contact the VT AOE Home Study Team at 802-828-6225 or [aoe.homestudy@vermont.gov](mailto:aoe.homestudy@vermont.gov) to check on the enrollment status of students.

Students can be enrolled in both a MVSD school and a Home Study Program as long as they take at least three (3) of the core academics at home. Core academics include reading/writing, math, history/citizenship/government, literature, and natural sciences.
